

# Notice of Election and Requirements for Voter Identification

Local Authorities Election Act  
(Sections 12,35,46, 53)

Notice is hereby given that an election will be held for the filling of the following offices:

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Voting will take place on **Saturday the 19<sup>th</sup> day of August, 2017, between the hours of 10:00 am and 7:00 pm.**

Voting station will be located at:

**Waiparous Community Services Facility located at 2 Wildrose Place, Waiparous Alberta**

In order to vote, you must produce identification for inspection. The identification must be one of the following showing name and address as required by section 53 of the Local Authorities Election Act:

- Photo identification issued by a Canadian government or agency, whether federal, provincial or local;
- Bank/credit card statement or personal cheque;
- Correspondence issued by a school, college or university;
- Government cheque or cheque stub;
- Income/property tax assessment notice;
- Insurance policy or coverage card;
- Letter from a public curator, public guardian or public trustee;
- Pension Plan statement of benefits, contributions or participation;
- Residential lease or mortgage statement;
- Statement of government benefits: e.g. Employment insurance, old-age security, social assistance, disability support, or child tax benefit;
- Utility bill: e.g. Telephone, public utilities commission, television, electricity, gas or water;
- Vehicle ownership, registration or insurance certificate; or
- A letter or form (attestation) confirming that the person lives at the stated address. The letter can be signed by an authorized representative of any of the following: a commercial property management company; a correctional institution; a First Nations band or reserve; a post-secondary institution; a facility that provides services to the homeless; or a supportive living facility or treatment centre;

# Not around on Election Day?

If an elector is unable to attend the voting station on Election Day – August 19<sup>th</sup>, due to physical incapacity or absence from the summer village on election day, a special ballot may be requested by an elector to the returning officer either:

- in writing,
- by fax, or
- by email.

An application must include:

- first and last name of elector;
- municipal address of the residence of the elector (Waiparous address);
- mailing address to which the special ballot is to be sent;
- contact telephone number;
- contact email address (if elector is unavailable by phone) and;
- reason why a special ballot is being requested.

If you feel you require a special ballot, please contact Sherri Bureyko, Returning Officer, as soon as possible to ensure there is ample time for us to mail out a special ballot package to you and for it to be received by the Returning Officer on or before 4:00 pm on THURSDAY AUGUST 17, 2017.
