Re: Highway 40 Proposed New Bridge

The Council of the Summer Village of Waiparous formally met on November 22, 2017. By resolution, Council indicated that they support replacing the bridge in its current location. Council hereby requests that the scope of the bridge design project currently underway on the recommended alignment from the *Hwy 40 Functional Planning Study*, be expanded to include one additional alternative, that being the replacement of the bridge in its current location.
